PROGRAM DETAILS

In partnership with the Kauffman Foundation, the Kansas City School Leader Collective is a unique cohort-based development opportunity meeting monthly throughout the 2020-2021 school year.

Who can join? KC SLC is open to school leaders in the Kansas City region who are currently:

- located in the six-county metropolitan Kansas City area (Jackson, Platte, Clay, Cass of MO and Wyandotte, Johnson of KS)
- an assistant principal, vice principal, dean, instructional coach or equivalent role
- working in schools with at least one of the following characteristics:
 - serving a student population that is higher than 40% free and reduced lunch
 - with a performance gap between student populations
 - within a school district that has experienced growth in its ELL population over the past three year

What is the commitment?

- bring a growth mindset to both your development and that of your peers
- attend all seven full-day Learning Lab sessions
- complete the SLC Leadership Development Project
